AN ACT CONCERNING GIFTED AND TALENTED STUDENT IDENTIFICATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 10 of the general statutes be amended to require that, upon
- 2 the identification of a child as gifted and talented, the local or regional
- 3 board of education responsible for educating such child shall develop
- 4 a list of educational needs that are not likely to be met by the general
- 5 education program at such child's school, such as instructional,
- 6 psychological and social-emotional, and that such list shall be
- 7 provided to the parents or guardians of such child and the principal of
- 8 the school that such child is enrolled.

Statement of Purpose:

To require the development and communication of a list of educational needs that are not likely to be met by the general education program at a child's school after such child has been identified as gifted and talented.

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
