## AN ACT ALLOWING THE USE OF SELF-SERVE ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR MACHINES BY CERTAIN PERMITTEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That title 30 of the general statutes be amended to allow a permittee 2 authorized pursuant to said title to sell alcoholic liquor for on-premises 3 consumption via an automated machine that, upon activation of a 4 payment card by the permittee, may be operated to dispense beer, 5 cider not exceeding six per cent alcohol by volume and wine to the 6 following: (1) An employee of the permittee who is authorized by law 7 to serve alcoholic beverages, or (2) a person whom the permittee has 8 verified to be twenty-one years of age or older who displays a 9 government-issued identification card that matches the name on the 10 payment card. Such verification that a person is twenty-one years of 11 age or older shall be recorded by the permittee or an employee of the 12 permittee.

## Statement of Purpose:

To allow the use of self-serve alcoholic liquor machines on certain permit premises.
