AN ACT PENALIZING PERSONS WHO MISREPRESENT THEMSELVES AS SOCIAL WORKERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 20 of the general statutes be amended to establish financial
- 2 penalties for persons who misrepresent themselves as social workers
- 3 without holding a baccalaureate or master's degree in social work from
- 4 a program accredited by the Council on Social Work Education.

Statement of Purpose:

To prevent unqualified persons from holding themselves out as and practicing as social workers.
