## AN ACT CONCERNING ADULTS COERCING JUVENILES TO COMMIT GANG-RELATED CRIMES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 53a of the general statutes be amended to make it a
- 2 criminal offense for any adult to coerce or conspire with a juvenile to
- 3 commit a gang-related crime if the adult has knowledge that such
- 4 juvenile is under eighteen years of age and the adult has coerced or
- 5 conspired with the juvenile with the knowledge and intention that the
- 6 juvenile will face a reduced criminal penalty due to the juvenile's age,
- 7 to provide that such offense shall be a class D felony and to further
- 8 provide that a state's attorney shall not be precluded from charging a
- 9 person charged under such offense with any other charge available to
- 10 the state's attorney.

## Statement of Purpose:

To prevent adult offenders from utilizing juveniles in the commission of gang-related crimes.
