AN ACT REQUIRING PUBLIC EMPLOYERS TO PROVIDE EXCLUSIVE REPRESENTATIVES WITH CERTAIN EMPLOYEE-RELATED INFORMATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require a public employer
- 2 to provide an exclusive representative with the following information
- 3 for all employees in the bargaining unit at least every one hundred
- 4 twenty days, unless more frequent or more detailed information is
- 5 required by a memorandum of understanding: (1) Name, job title,
- 6 department and work location, and (2) if it is part of the employers'
- 7 records, the home address, telephone number and email address on
- 8 file with the employer.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide more timely and accurate employee data.

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
