AN ACT REQUIRING DISCLOSURE OF THE SALARY RANGE OF A VACANT EMPLOYMENT POSITION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) (a) The Labor Commissioner
2 shall study whether employers in this state should be required to
3 disclose to job applicants the salary ranges for advertised vacant
4 employment positions.

5 (b) On or before January 1, 2020, the commissioner shall report the
6 results of the study conducted pursuant to subsection (a) of this
7 section, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the
8 general statutes, to the joint standing committee of the General
9 Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to labor.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
