## AN ACT REQUIRING DISCLOSURE OF THE SALARY RANGE OF A VACANT EMPLOYMENT POSITION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) (a) The Labor Commissioner
- shall study whether employers in this state should be required to
- 3 disclose to job applicants the salary ranges for advertised vacant
- 4 employment positions.
- 5 (b) On or before January 1, 2020, the commissioner shall report the
- results of the study conducted pursuant to subsection (a) of this
- 7 section, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the
- 8 general statutes, to the joint standing committee of the General
- 9 Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to labor.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
