AN ACT REGULATING SURGE PRICING BY TRANSPORTATION NETWORK COMPANIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 13b-118 of the general statutes be amended to require
- 2 the Commissioner of Transportation establish the maximum rate that
- 3 transportation network companies may charge for a prearranged ride
- 4 and ensure such rate does not exceed the rates established for taxicabs.

Statement of Purpose:

To protect consumers from surge pricing by transportation network companies by requiring the Commissioner of Transportation to establish the maximum rate that such companies may charge for a prearranged ride.
