## AN ACT CONCERNING THE STATE CONTRACTING STANDARDS BOARD AND REQUIREMENTS FOR PRIVATIZATION CONTRACTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 4e of the general statutes be amended to expand the
- 2 requirements for privatizing state services by (1) including quasi-
- 3 public agencies; (2) adding additional requirements for privatizing
- 4 services that are currently privatized; (3) requiring state and quasi-
- 5 public agencies that enter into certain privatization contracts to submit
- 6 plans for hiring more state employees; (4) prohibiting certain
- 7 privatization contracts (A) without the Attorney General's formal
- 8 approval, and (B) unless certain certifications are posted on the State
- 9 Contracting Portal at least thirty days before the contract's execution;
- 10 (5) expanding the State Contracting Standards Board's authority over
- 11 the constituent units of higher education; and (6) requiring state
- 12 contracting agencies to assume certain duties if the State Contracting
- 13 Standards Board is determined to be understaffed.
