AN ACT EXEMPTING VETERANS FROM THE PASSPORT TO THE PARKS MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION PROGRAM FEE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

Section 1. Subsection (b) of section 14-49b of the general statutes is
repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2019*):

4 (b) For each new registration or renewal of registration of any motor 5 vehicle with the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles pursuant to this chapter, the person registering such vehicle shall pay to the 6 7 commissioner a fee of ten dollars for registration for a biennial period 8 for the following registration types: Passenger, motorcycle, motor 9 home, combination or antique. Any person who is sixty-five years or 10 older and who obtains a one-year registration renewal under section 11 14-49 for such registration type shall pay five dollars for the annual 12 registration period. Any person who is a veteran, as defined in 13 subsection (a) of section 27-103, shall be exempt from payment of the fee required by this subsection, provided such person presents to the 14 15 commissioner or the commissioner's authorized representative 16 documentation that indicates such person's status as a veteran. The 17 provisions of this subsection shall not apply to any motor vehicle that 18 is not self-propelled or that is exempted from payment of a registration 19 fee. This fee shall be identified as the "Passport to the Parks Fee" on 20 any registration form provided by the commissioner. Payments 21 collected pursuant to the provisions of this subsection shall be 22 deposited in the Passport to the Parks account established pursuant to 23 section 23-15h. The fee required by this subsection is in addition to any 24 other fees prescribed by any other provision of this title for the 25 registration of a motor vehicle. No part of the "Passport to the Parks 26 Fee" shall be subject to a refund under subsection (aa) of section 14-49.
