AN ACT CONCERNING PARAEDUCATOR PAY EQUITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

Section 1. (NEW) (Effective January 1, 2020) (a) The Commissioner of 1 2 Education shall evaluate classifications of noncertified board of 3 education employees on a periodic basis of not less than five years, to 4 determine if such classifications are in the appropriate compensation 5 plan, based upon appropriate and reasonably objective job-related 6 criteria. Such objective job-related criteria required to carry out the 7 duties of the position shall include, but not be limited to: (1) 8 Knowledge and skill, (2) mental and physical effort, and (3) 9 commissioner shall accountability. The establish 10 committees, consisting of representatives of local and regional boards 11 of education, management and employees in classifications being 12 evaluated pursuant to this subsection. The commissioner shall 13 determine ratings for classifications through assignment of factor 14 values. No modification of compensation shall be required pursuant to 15 such ratings. Such ratings may be considered in regard to setting 16 compensation for noncertified local and regional board of education 17 employees, subject to the provisions of applicable municipal 18 paraeducator collective bargaining agreements and municipal 19 collective bargaining provisions under sections 7-467 to 7-477, 20 inclusive, of the general statutes, for classifications included under

- 21 collective bargaining.
- 22 (b) Any position may be excluded from the evaluation conducted 23 pursuant to subsection (a) of this section if the commissioner and an 24 exclusive bargaining representative mutually agree to exclude such 25 position.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following
