AN ACT CONCERNING THE ORGANIZATION OF THE CONNECTICUT STATE GUARD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

Section 1. Section 27-9 of the general statutes is repealed and the
following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July 1, 2019*):

3 [Whenever the Connecticut National Guard is called into the federal 4 service or whenever such a call, in the opinion of the Governor, is 5 deemed to be imminent, the Governor shall forthwith] The Governor 6 may raise, organize, maintain and govern [, from the unorganized 7 militia,] a body of volunteer troops for state military duty. Said body of 8 troops [, when so organized,] shall be known as "the Connecticut State 9 Guard" and [for and during the time of its existence as herein provided 10 it] shall be a part of the organized militia.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Section 1 July 1, 2019 27-9

Statement of Purpose:

To clarify the Governor's authority with respect to the command and control of the Connecticut State Guard.
