## AN ACT CONCERNING THE FILLING OF BOARD OF EDUCATION VACANCIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

Section 1. Section 10-219 of the general statutes is repealed and the
following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2019*):

If a vacancy occurs in the office of any member of the local board of education, unless otherwise provided by <u>section 7-107</u>, charter or special act, such vacancy shall be filled by the remaining members of said board until the next regular town election, at which election a successor shall be elected for the unexpired portion of the term, the official ballot specifying the vacancy to be filled.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

## Statement of Purpose:

To specify that a board of selectmen or the chief executive official of a municipality, as applicable, has the authority to fill a vacancy on a local board of education if such vacancy is not filled by such board within thirty days after the occurrence of such vacancy.
