## AN ACT CONCERNING SOCIAL WORKER TITLE PROTECTION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. Subsections (a) and (b) of section 20-195q of the general
- 2 statutes are repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof
- 3 (*Effective January 1, 2021*):
- 4 (a) No person shall (1) use the title <u>"social worker" or</u> "licensed
- 5 master social worker" or any initials associated with such [title] titles,
- 6 or (2) advertise services under the description of a licensed master
- social worker, as defined in section 20-195m, unless such person is
- 8 licensed as a master social worker pursuant to this chapter.
- 9 (b) No person shall (1) use the title <u>"social worker" or</u> "licensed
- 10 clinical social worker" or any initials associated with such [title] <u>titles</u>,
- 11 or (2) advertise services under the description of a licensed clinical
- 12 social worker, as defined in section 20-195m, unless such person is
- 13 licensed as a clinical social worker pursuant to this chapter.
