## AN ACT CONCERNING FUNDING FOR ASSISTANCE TO PERSONS DISPLACED BY HURRICANE MARIA.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. Section 19 of public act 18-81 is repealed and the
- 2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from passage*):
- The following sums appropriated in section 1 of public act 17-2 of
- 4 the June special session, as amended by section 16 of public act 17-4 of
- 5 the June special session, section 1 of public act 17-1 of the January
- 6 special session and section 1 of [this act] <u>public act 18-81</u>, for the fiscal
- 7 year ending June 30, 2019, shall be for the purpose of providing
- 8 assistance to persons residing in the state who were displaced by
- 9 Hurricane Maria as follows: (1) \$400,000 to the Department of
- Education, for Bilingual Education, to be distributed to the top six school districts with the largest concentration of Hurricane Maria
- 12 evacuees; (2) \$600,000 to the Department of Housing, for

- 13 Housing/Homeless Services, to fund security deposits and first month
- rent to those evacuees impacted by Hurricane Maria; and (3) \$500,000
- 15 to the Department of Social Services, for Human Resource
- 16 Development-Hispanic Programs, as follows: \$90,000 to the Hispanic
- 17 Coalition Inc. in Waterbury, \$90,000 to Junta For Progressive Action in
- 18 New Haven, \$90,000 to Family Resource Center in Hartford for
- 19 Hartford Public Schools The Welcome Center, \$90,000 to Caribe
- 20 Youth Leaders in [Waterbury] Bridgeport, \$40,000 to Casa Boricua in
- 21 Meriden, \$40,000 to Human Resource Agency of New Britain Inc. in
- 22 New Britain, \$40,000 to YMCA of Greater Hartford, Larson Center and
- 23 \$20,000 to Thames Valley Council for Community Action in New
- 24 London.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
