AN ACT ESTABLISHING A REFUNDABLE CREDIT AGAINST THE PERSONAL INCOME TAX FOR LICENSED DRIVERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 12 of the general statutes be amended to establish, for
- 2 taxable years commencing on or after January 1, 2022, a refundable
- 3 credit against the personal income tax of fifty dollars for each licensed
- 4 driver, regardless of filing status.

Statement of Purpose:

To establish a refundable credit against the personal income tax of fifty dollars for each licensed driver, regardless of filing status.

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
