AN ACT PROHIBITING SMOKING IN MOTOR VEHICLES WHEN A CHILD IS PRESENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 246 of the general statutes be amended to prohibit a
- 2 person from smoking or using an electronic nicotine delivery system or
- 3 vapor product in a motor vehicle when a child under eighteen years of
- 4 age is present in such vehicle and provide that any violation of such
- 5 prohibition is an infraction.

Statement of Purpose:

To protect children from secondhand smoke while riding in a motor vehicle.
