AN ACT ADDING OPIOID USE DISORDER AND WITHDRAWAL AS A DEBILITATING MEDICAL CONDITION FOR THE PALLIATIVE USE OF MARIJUANA.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 420f of the general statutes be amended to add opioid
- 2 use disorder and withdrawal as qualifying conditions that qualify for
- 3 the palliative use of marijuana.
