AN ACT CONCERNING PROFESSIONAL APPLICATION AND LICENSING FEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to (1) eliminate application
- 2 review fees charged by state licensing boards, and (2) limit the amount
- 3 the state may charge for an occupational license to not more than one
- 4 hundred dollars per two-year license period.

Statement of Purpose:

To (1) eliminate application review fees charged by state licensing boards, and (2) limit the amount the state may charge for an occupational license to not more than one hundred dollars per two-year license period.
