# AN ACT CONCERNING FUNDING FOR SCHOOL-BASED HEALTH CENTERS IN EASTERN CONNECTICUT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the sum of one million two hundred thousand dollars be
- 2 appropriated to the Department of Public Health, from the General
- Fund, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2025, for school-based health
- 4 centers established in eastern Connecticut, including, but not limited to,
- 5 at the Charles Barnum Elementary School, Northeast Academy Arts
- 6 Magnet School and Ella T. Grasso Southeastern Technical High School
- 7 located in the town of Groton, Ledyard High School, Ledyard Middle
- 8 School and the Juliet Long School located in the town of Ledyard, and
- 9 Stonington High School and West Vine Street School located in the town

10 of Stonington.
