AN ACT CONCERNING MILEAGE REIMBURSEMENT FOR LEGISLATORS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 2-15 of the general statutes be amended to restrict the
- 2 transportation allowance to members or members-elect who drive a
- 3 motor vehicle from their home to the State Capitol or other location
- 4 where a public hearing or meeting is held and to change such allowance
- 5 to a reimbursement for the miles actually driven by such member.

Statement of Purpose:

To reduce costs to the state by ensuring that legislators are reimbursed only for the mileage that they have driven.
