AN ACT CONCERNING CERTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS FOR OUT-OF-STATE SCHOOL ADMINISTRATORS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 166 of the general statutes be amended to require the
- 2 Department of Education to issue professional certification to an
- 3 educator who is properly certified in another state, and to issue a
- 4 superintendent of schools administrative endorsement to an individual
- 5 who is properly certified in another state as a superintendent and who
- 6 has completed coursework for such out-of-state certification that is
- 7 similar to the requirements for such endorsement in this state.

Statement of Purpose:

To encourage the relocation and employment of out-of-state school administrators in Connecticut public schools.

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
