AN ACT PROHIBITING THE USE OF STYROFOAM TRAYS IN CONNECTICUT SCHOOLS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (Effective from passage) On and after the effective
- date of this section, no school district or regional school district shall
- 3 enter a contract for the purchase of any tray made from expanded
- 4 polystyrene. Not later than October 1, 2019, each school district and
- 5 regional school district shall develop a plan for discontinuing the use
- 6 in such district of trays made from expanded polystyrene. Such plan
- shall require the district to discontinue such use not later than July 1,
- 8 2020. For purposes of this section, "expanded polystyrene" means
- 9 blown polystyrene and expanded and extruded foams that are
- 10 thermoplastic petrochemical materials utilizing a styrene monomer
- and processed by any number of techniques including, but not limited
- 12 to, fusion of polymer spheres, injection molding, foam molding and
- 13 extrusion-blown molding.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
