AN ACT PROVIDING RELIEF TO FRONTLINE PHYSICIANS AND OTHER HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS FIGHTING THE PANDEMIC.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

That the general statutes be amended to provide hospital funding that would provide grants for training of health care providers in

3 strategies to reduce and prevent suicide, burnout, and mental health

4 conditions, evidence-based strategies to reduce burnout and the

5 associated secondary mental health conditions related to job stress

6 during the pandemic for physicians and other health care providers,

7 peer support programming and appropriate staffing levels of

8 administrative and support personnel to reduce administrative loads on

9 physicians and to increase physician recruitment and reduce continuous

10 on-call demands of physicians.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide meaningful relief to frontline physicians and health care workers fighting the current pandemic.
