AN ACT REQUIRING PENSIONS FOR POLICE OFFICERS AND FIREFIGHTERS EMPLOYED BY MUNICIPALITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (Effective October 1, 2024) Each municipality, as
- 2 defined in section 7-148 of the general statutes, shall provide each police
- 3 officer or firefighter employed by such municipality with pension
- 4 benefits, either through participation in (1) the municipal employees'
- 5 retirement system, pursuant to section 7-427 of the general statutes, or
- 6 (2) any other retirement system that provides such individuals with
- 7 benefits that are comparable or superior to those benefits offered by the
- 8 municipal employees' retirement system.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Statement of Purpose:

To require that municipalities employing police officers and firefighters provide such officers and firefighters with pensions through the

municipal employees' retirement system or another system that offers comparable or superior benefits.
