**AN ACT CONCERNING THE PROCESSING OF WORK OPPORTUNITY
TAX CREDIT APPLICATIONS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2019*) (a) The Department of Labor
2 shall: (1) Process forty per cent of all Work Opportunity Tax Credits
3 submitted and in its possession not later than July 1, 2020, (2) process
4 sixty per cent of all Work Opportunity Tax Credits submitted and in its
5 possession not later than July 1, 2021, (3) process eighty per cent of all
6 Work Opportunity Tax Credits submitted and in its possession not
7 later than July 1, 2022, and (4) process one hundred per cent of all
8 Work Opportunity Tax Credits submitted and in its possession not
9 later than July 1, 2023.

10 (b) Not later than July 1, 2020, the Department of Labor shall pursue
11 a method to receive and process all applications for Work Opportunity
12 Tax Credits electronically. Such method shall include the ability to
13 receive or access information electronically held by other relevant state
14 agencies.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:		
Section 1	July 1, 2019	New section

Statement of Purpose:

To require the Labor Department to process applications for the Work Opportunity Tax Credit and issue the tax credit certifications in a timely manner.
