## AN ACT CONCERNING THE STATUTE OF LIMITATIONS FOR THE CRIME OF ABUSING AN ELDERLY PERSON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to provide that
- 2 notwithstanding the provisions of section 54-193 of the general statutes,
- 3 no person may be prosecuted for any offense under title 53 or 53a of the
- 4 general statutes as a result of an investigation of the exploitation of an
- 5 elderly person, as defined in section 17b-450 of the general statutes,
- 6 except within five years from the date of the discovery of such offense
- 7 or within five years from the date of the death of such elderly person,
- 8 whichever shall first occur.

## Statement of Purpose:

To amend the statute of limitations for the crime of abusing an elderly person to provide that the five-year period be based on the discovery of the offense or the death of the elderly person.
