AN ACT CONCERNING THE DEPARTMENT OF DEVELOPMENTAL SERVICES' LEVEL OF NEED ASSESSMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (Effective October 1, 2019) Not later than January 1, 2020,
- 2 the Department of Developmental Services shall (1) analyze
- 3 information, policies and terminology relating to medical assessments
- 4 and update the department's level of need assessment, as defined in
- 5 section 17a-238a of the general statutes, as necessary to reflect the most
- 6 recent information, policies and terminology, and (2) within available
- 7 appropriations, consult with family members, providers and advocates
- 8 of persons with intellectual disability in updating the department's
- 9 level of need assessment.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Section 1 October 1, 2019 New section

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Statement of Purpose:

To require the Department of Developmental Services to use up-todate medical assessment policies and consult with families, providers and advocates for persons with intellectual disability in its level of need assessment.
