AN ACT ESTABLISHING A TASK FORCE TO STUDY ISSUES RELATED TO PROTECTING MIXED-USE BUILDING RESIDENTS AND OCCUPANTS FROM SECONDHAND SMOKE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That a task force be established to study and make recommendations
- 2 concerning issues related to protecting and safeguarding occupants and
- 3 residents of mixed-use buildings from harm caused by secondhand
- 4 smoke, especially residents and occupants who suffer from impaired
- 5 respiratory function or another respiratory disability.

Statement of Purpose:

To establish a task force to study and make recommendations concerning issues related to protecting and safeguarding occupants and residents of mixed-use buildings from harm caused by secondhand smoke, especially residents and occupants who suffer from impaired respiratory function or another respiratory disability.
