AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CAPITAL REGION DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY TO ESTABLISH A HARTFORD CONVENTION AND VISITORS BUREAU.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) The Capital Region
2 Development Authority established under section 32-601 of the general
3 statutes may establish a Hartford Convention and Visitors Bureau to
4 promote the city of Hartford as a convention, trade show and sporting
5 events destination and support the hospitality and tourism industries
6 within said city. The authority may consult with the mayor of the city of
7 Hartford, the board of directors of any regional tourism district
8 established under section 10-397 of the general statutes and the
9 Department of Economic and Community Development, and utilize
10 any of the authority's powers enumerated in section 32-602 of the
11 general statutes, to accomplish the purposes of this section.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
