AN ACT CONCERNING FIREFIGHTER WORK WEEKS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- Section 1. Section 7-305 of the general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective January 1, 2020*):
- (a) The work week for all permanent paid members of the
 uniformed firefighter force for municipalities adopting sections 7-303
 to 7-306, inclusive, shall be an average work week of not more than
 fifty-six hours, computed over a period of one fiscal or calendar year,
- as the municipality elects; provided, unless otherwise prescribed by
- 8 regulation or ordinance, any time spent in an emergency in excess of
- 9 any regularly assigned or scheduled work week in connection with
- any actual fire or conflagration, including time spent going to, working
- 11 at or returning from any actual fire, or any other work or duty
- 12 classified as an act of mercy shall not be included in computing such
- 13 average work week.
- 14 (b) Notwithstanding subsection (a) of this section or any ordinance
- 15 adopted pursuant to section 7-304, the work week and average work
- week for all permanent paid members of the uniformed firefighter

- force for municipalities shall be a subject of collective bargaining for 17
- such members in accordance with sections 7-467 to 7-477, inclusive, of 18
- the general statutes and applicable to any such collective bargaining 19
- agreement negotiated, entered into, renewed or extended on or after 20
- 21 January 1, 2020.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following
