AN ACT CONCERNING REVIEW AND DISMISSAL OF COMPLAINTS BY THE STATE ELECTIONS ENFORCEMENT COMMISSION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 9-7a of the general statutes be amended to provide that
- 2 (1) the State Elections Enforcement Commission shall (A) establish a
- dormancy docket consisting of any complaint or enforcement action
- 4 that has not been acted upon in a certain amount of time, and (B)
- 5 prescribe the timeline and procedures for review of any such
- complaint or enforcement action for dismissal due to such inaction, 6
- and (2) the respondent or respondents to any such complaint or
- 8 enforcement action may bring an interlocutory appeal to the Superior
- 9 Court if such complaint or enforcement action has been ongoing for
- 10 two years and no hearing thereon has been held.

Statement of Purpose:

To establish procedures for the timely review and disposition of certain election complaints.
