AN ACT CONCERNING THE DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION'S NINETY-DAY PERMIT APPLICATION DETERMINATION REQUIREMENT AND THE STATE'S SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 To amend the ninety-day permit turnaround requirement contained
- 2 in section 22a-6ee of the general statutes, to increase the number of
- 3 permits subject to such requirement and to adjust and possibly reduce
- 4 the state's solid waste management plan concerning recycling goals in
- 5 the state.

Statement of Purpose:

To amend the ninety-day permit determination requirement of the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection and the state-wide solid waste management plan for the state concerning recycling.
