AN ACT CONCERNING STATE EMPLOYEE REPORTING OF WASTEFUL PRACTICES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 4-61dd of the general statutes be amended to provide
- 2 that any state employee who makes a report to the Auditors of Public
- 3 Accounts that concerns a wasteful practice by a state department or
- 4 agency shall receive ten per cent of the estimated savings to the state
- 5 that is attributable to the stopping of such wasteful practice.

Statement of Purpose:

To offer a financial incentive for state employees who report wasteful spending within the government.
