AN ACT CONCERNING THE TRANSFER OF LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY RECORDS BETWEEN AGENCIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2019*) A law enforcement agency that discloses records that may be withheld from disclosure under subdivision (3) of subsection (b) of section 1-210 of the general statutes to another law enforcement agency that is permitted to receive such records shall not be liable for any further disclosure of such records by the agency receiving the records.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:		
Section 1	July 1, 2019	New section

Statement of Purpose:

To protect a law enforcement agency that transfers records to another law enforcement agency from liability if the other agency further discloses such records.
