AN ACT CONCERNING THE PALLIATIVE AND RECREATIONAL USE OF MARIJUANA.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 12 and chapter 420f of the general statutes be amended to
- 2 provide for changes to the palliative use of marijuana program,
- 3 including, but not limited to, an exemption for medical marijuana from
- 4 the sales tax, the addition of chronic pain as a qualifying condition, the
- 5 reduction in the annual medical marijuana patient fee to fifty dollars,
- 6 the elimination of the twenty-five-dollar registration fee for veterans
- 7 who have a primary caregiver and that the general statutes be
- 8 amended to establish, tax and regulate a recreational use of marijuana
- 9 program for adults twenty-one years of age or older.

Statement of Purpose:

To amend the palliative marijuana program and to establish and regulate a recreational use of marijuana program.
