## AN ACT PROHIBITING ON-CALL SHIFT SCHEDULING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to prohibit the employment
- 2 practice of requiring an employee to call an employer prior to a
- 3 scheduled shift to confirm that the employee is needed for the shift,
- 4 and to require employers to give an employee at least twenty-four
- 5 hours prior notice if the employee is not needed to work a scheduled
- 6 shift.

## Statement of Purpose:

To prohibit the unfair employment practice of on-call shift scheduling.
