**AN ACT CONCERNING REIMBURSEMENT TO LAW ENFORCEMENT
UNITS FOR TRAINING COSTS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 7-294dd of the general statutes be amended to expand
- 2 the definition of training costs for which a law enforcement unit
- 3 receives reimbursement after a police officer trained by the unit later
- 4 becomes employed by another law enforcement unit.

Statement of Purpose:

To ensure a law enforcement unit receives reimbursement for training
costs after a police officer trained by the unit later becomes employed
by another law enforcement unit.
