## AN ACT PROHIBITING A FINDING OF NEGLECT IN CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. Subdivision (4) of section 46b-120 of the general statutes is
- 2 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (Effective July
- 3 1, 2019):
- 4 (4) A child may be found "neglected" who, for reasons other than
- 5 being impoverished, (A) has been abandoned, (B) is being denied
- 6 proper care and attention, physically, educationally, emotionally or
- 7 morally, or (C) is being permitted to (i) live under conditions,
- 8 circumstances or associations injurious to the well-being of the child,
- 9 or (ii) engage in unsupervised independent activities due to the
- 10 <u>unreasonable belief of such child's parent or guardian that such child is</u>
- 11 of sufficient maturity, physical condition or mental ability to avoid
- 12 <u>engaging in any such activity that poses a substantial risk of harm;</u>

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Section 1	July 1, 2019	46b-120(4)

## Statement of Legislative Commissioners:

In Section 1, "conduct that carries" was replaced with "any such activity that poses" for clarity.
