AN ACT CONCERNING SERVICES FOR PERSONS WITH SMITH-MAGENIS SYNDROME.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (Effective from passage) (a) For purposes of this section,
- 2 "Smith-Magenis Syndrome" means a genetically based, developmental
- 3 disorder that includes, but is not limited to, mild to moderate
- 4 intellectual disability, delayed speech and language skills, distinctive
- 5 facial features, sleep disturbances and behavioral problems.
- 6 (b) The Commissioner of Developmental Services, in consultation
- 7 with the Commissioners of Early Childhood, Education, Mental Health
- 8 and Addiction Services, Public Health and Social Services, shall study
- 9 whether children with Smith-Magenis Syndrome are receiving
- 10 adequate services, including, but not limited to, early intervention,
- 11 special education and other supportive services. The commissioner
- shall develop recommendations as necessary to improve such services.
- 13 (c) Not later than January 15, 2020, the commissioner shall report on
- 14 the results of the study in accordance with the provisions of section 11-

- 15 4a of the general statutes to the joint standing committees of the
- 16 General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to children,
- 17 education, public health and human services.
