AN ACT CONCERNING LIABILITY FOR INJURIES OCCURRING IN A SKATEBOARD PARK OR A DOG PARK MAINTAINED BY A MUNICIPALITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2019*) Each person engaged in skateboarding activities at a municipally maintained skateboard park
- 3 shall assume the risk and legal responsibility for any injury to his or
- 4 her person or property arising out of the hazards inherent with the
- 5 activity of skateboarding, unless the injury was proximately caused by
- 6 the municipality's failure to guard or warn against a dangerous
- 7 condition, use or structure at the municipally maintained skateboard
- 8 park.
- 9 Sec. 2. (NEW) (Effective October 1, 2019) A municipality that makes
- 10 part of the municipality's land available to the public without charge,
- 11 rent, fee or other commercial service for use as a dog park shall be
- 12 immune from liability in any civil action that results from injury to any
- 13 person or property at such dog park unless such injury was
- 14 proximately caused by the negligence of the municipality for failing to

- 15 guard or warn against a dangerous condition, use, structure or activity
- 16 at the municipality's dog park.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following		
sections:

Statement of Purpose:

To reduce a municipality's potential exposure for liability for injuries occurring in a municipally maintained skateboard park or dog park.
