Substitute Bill No. 1003



AN ACT ESTABLISHING A MUNICIPAL TREE REMOVAL GRANT PROGRAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (Effective July 1, 2023) (a) For the purposes of this section,
- 2 "municipality" means any town, city, borough, consolidated town and
- 3 city or consolidated town and borough, and "municipal road" has the
- 4 same meaning as provided in section 13a-110a of the general statutes.
- 5 (b) There is established an account to be known as the "municipal
- 6 tree removal account" which shall be a separate, nonlapsing account
- 7 within the General Fund. The account shall contain any moneys
- 8 required by law to be deposited in the account. Moneys in the account
- 9 shall be expended by the Commissioner of Energy and Environmental
- 10 Protection for the purposes described in subsection (c) of this section.
- 11 (c) For the fiscal years ending June 30, 2024, to June 30, 2028,
- 12 inclusive, the Commissioner of Energy and Environmental Protection
- 13 shall administer a municipal tree removal grant program to provide
- 14 grants to municipalities for the removal of dead, dying and hazardous
- 15 trees, tree limbs and tree branches from municipal property and
- 16 municipal roads. The commissioner shall establish a grant application
- 17 process, eligibility criteria for the provision of grants, a formula for
- 18 determining the amount of each grant awarded pursuant to this
- 19 subsection and guidelines for the acceptable expenditure of grant

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20 funds by municipalities.

21 (d) Any municipality receiving a grant pursuant to this section shall 22 file an annual expenditure report with the Commissioner of Energy 23 and Environmental Protection at such time, and in such manner as the 24 commissioner prescribes. Grant recipients shall refund to the 25 Department of Energy and Environmental Protection any amounts not 26 expended (1) at the close of the fiscal year in which a grant was 27 awarded, and (2) in accordance with the guidelines for acceptable 28 expenditures of grant funds established pursuant to subsection (c) of 29 this section.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
