Substitute Bill No. 1020

AN ACT ESTABLISHING A REGIONAL ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PILOT PROGRAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (Effective July 1, 2021) (a) The Department of 2 Economic and Community Development shall establish, within 3 available appropriations, a regional economic development matching grant pilot program for the purpose of providing matching funds to 4 5 regional economic development corporations for the implementation of 6 economic development programs in distressed municipalities. Such 7 pilot program shall be available to any regional development 8 corporation representing not less than five municipalities, two of which 9 shall be distressed municipalities, as defined in section 32-9p of the 10 general statutes. The department may enter into an agreement, pursuant 11 to chapter 55a of the general statutes, with a person, firm, corporation 12 or other entity to operate such program.

(b) Applications for participation in such pilot program shall be
submitted in a manner prescribed by the department. Each application
shall include, but need not be limited to, the following: (1) The location
of the principal place of business of the applicant; (2) an explanation of
the economic development program for which the matching grant is
being applied; (3) the amount and source of funding for such program

the applicant seeks to have matched; and (4) such other information the
department deems necessary. The department shall not accept new
applications for the regional economic development matching grant
pilot program after June 30, 2026.

23 (c) In determining whether an applicant shall be selected for a 24 matching grant pursuant to this section, the department, or the operator, 25 if any, selected pursuant to subsection (a) of this section, shall consider, 26 but need not be limited to, the following factors: (1) The description of 27 the economic development program proposed by the applicant; (2) the resources and record of success of the applicant relative to economic 28 29 development programs implemented by the applicant in the applicant's 30 region; and (3) the potential impact of the proposed economic 31 development program on the workforce in the region where the 32 applicant is located. The department may provide, within available 33 funds, matching grants to eligible applicants for the funding of 34 economic development programs proposed in such applications.

(d) The Commissioner of Economic and Community Development
may award matching grants to regional economic development
corporations participating in the pilot program not exceeding in the
aggregate ten million dollars. The amount of any matching grant issued
pursuant to this section shall not exceed five million dollars.

40 (e) Not later than two years after the receipt of any financial aid 41 pursuant to this section, and annually thereafter, each regional 42 economic development corporation participating in the pilot program 43 shall submit a report to the Department of Economic and Community 44 Development detailing the progress of the economic development 45 program proposed in such corporation's application and containing any 46 additional information deemed necessary by the Commissioner of 47 Economic and Community Development.

(f) Not later than January 15, 2022, and annually thereafter, the
Commissioner of Economic and Community Development shall submit
a report, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general

- 52 the pilot program to the joint standing committee of the General
- 53 Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to commerce.
