Substitute Bill No. 1053

AN ACT EXPANDING MEDICAID AND HUSKY B COVERAGE FOR CHILDREN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 17b-261 of the general statutes is amended by 2 adding subsection (l) as follows (*Effective July 1, 2019*):

3 (NEW) (1) On and after July 1, 2019, the Commissioner of Social 4 Services shall provide state-funded medical assistance to a person 5 under the age of nineteen who is not a naturalized citizen regardless of 6 whether such person is a qualified alien, as described in section 17b-7 257a, provided the household income of such person does not exceed 8 one hundred ninety-six per cent of the federal poverty level without an 9 asset limit.

10 Sec. 2. Subsection (a) of section 17b-292 of the general statutes is 11 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July* 12 1, 2019):

13 (a) A child who resides in a household with household income 14 which exceeds one hundred ninety-six per cent of the federal poverty 15 level and does not exceed three hundred eighteen per cent of the 16 federal poverty level [may] <u>shall</u> be eligible for benefits under HUSKY 17 B regardless of whether such child has legal immigration status.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
