AN ACT CONCERNING THE ISSUANCE OF TEMPORARY FOOD SERVICE ESTABLISHMENT PERMITS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (*Effective July 1, 2019*) Not later than July 1, 2020, the
2 Commissioner of Public Health shall adopt regulations, in accordance
3 with the provisions of chapter 54 of the general statutes, to permit any
4 director of health to issue a permit for a temporary food service
5 establishment for a period exceeding fourteen days to any vendor that
6 intends to serve food and drink in a combined food hall and
7 marketplace.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Statement of Purpose:

To require the Commissioner of Public Health to authorize any director of health to issue a permit for a temporary food service establishment for a period exceeding fourteen days to any vendor that

intends to serve food and drink in a combined food hall and marketplace.
