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16 Councilmember Muriel Bowser introduced the following bill, which was referred to the

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19 To amend Section 47-3801 of the District of Columbia Official Code to include 14th
20 Street, N.W., between Spring Road and Longfellow Street as an area eligible for
21 Supermarket Tax Incentives.
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23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA,

24 That this act may be cited as the “The Central 14th Street N.W. Supermarket Incentive
25 Extension Amendment Act of 2013.”

26 Sec. 2. Section 47-3801 is amended as follows:

27 Subparagraph (1D) is amended as follows:

28 “(1D) “Eligible area” means:

29 (A) A historically underutilized business zone, as defined by section
30 3(p)(1) of the Small Business Act, approved July 18, 1958 (72 Stat. 384; 15 U.S.C.S. §
31 632(p)(1));

32 (B) Census tracts 18.01, 33.01, 95.05, 95.07, or 95.08; or

33 (C) The Central 14th Street Study Plan Area which shall consist of any
34 square located on or abutting 14th Street, N.W., beginning at the intersection of Spring

1 Road , N.W., and north on 14th Street , N.W., to Longfellow Street, N.W as well as the
2 800 block of Upshur Street, N.W.”.

3 Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.

4 The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the
5 fiscal impact statement required by section 602(c)(3) of the District of Columbia Home
6 Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02
7 (c)(3)).

8 Sec. 4. Effective date.

9 This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto
10 by the Mayor, action by Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of Congressional
11 review as provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act,
12 approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and
13 publication in the District of Columbia Register.
