

Amount differs from that of the base period and option periods due to an anticipated decrease in the amount of services and goods needing to be procured under this contract for the period of March 1, 2019 through March 31, 2019 (\$950,000.00 NTE), thereafter, April 4, 2019 through February 29, 2020 (\$9,050,000.00 NTE). There is no additional cost for the period of April 1, 2019 through April 3, 2019 (See M55).

(C) The goods or services to be provided, the methods of delivering goods or services, and any significant program changes reflected in the proposed contract:

The District of Columbia's Office of the Chief Technology Officer (OCTO) has a continued need for the Contractor to provide support services for the DC-NET Metropolitan Area Network Man-Based Telephony. This contract provides the necessary services to support DC-NET's fiber network and ensures dramatic expansion of its telecommunications network deployment to District government offices and agencies, and to non-commercial entities operating within the District.

Geographically, the District will continue to operate and grow within the physical boundaries of the District of Columbia at its three operating data center locations and District offices and sites, with expected physical extension limited to its planned operations hub in Reston, VA.

(D) The date on which a competitive procurement for these goods or services was last conducted, the date of the resulting award, and a detailed explanation of why a competitive procurement is not feasible:

On August 2, 2013, the Office of Contracting and Procurement issued a RFQ on behalf of the Office of the Chief Technology Officer to 59 Alliant Governmentwide Acquisition Contract (GWAC) holders. The solicitation closed September 5, 2013, with only one Offeror responding, SAIC. Upon Council approval, the contract, CW25961, was executed on March 6, 2014, between the District and SAIC for a base year and four one-year option periods.

The approval of an extension to CW25961 will allow the District to maintain continuity in the delivery of critical services for District residents and agencies. The extension is needed to allow for the District to complete a phased approach plan to the development of a new competitive solicitation.

(E) A description of any bid protest related to the award of the contract, including whether the protest was resolved through litigation, withdrawal of the protest by the protestor, or voluntary corrective action by the District. No bid protest relating to the award of this contract has been filed.

- (F) The background and qualifications of the proposed contractor, including its organization, financial stability, personnel, and performance on past or current government or private sector contracts with requirements similar to those of the proposed contract:**

Founded by J. Robert Beyster, Ph.D., and a small group of scientists in 1969, Science Applications International Corporation (SAIC), a FORTUNE 500® company, and its subsidiaries now have approximately 41,000 employees worldwide.

Integrated Services

SAIC's critical infrastructure services and deep domain experience combines design, construction, engineering, science, business processes, and information technology into a seamless integrated solution. Their multi-disciplinary teams go beyond the traditional problem-solving approach to help enable their customers to advance their capital programs, reduce costs, and operate more effectively.

SAIC maintains personnel that have expertise with fiber network construction services and have experience with developing facilities, networks, and infrastructure systems. SAIC's integrated project delivery methods transform design concepts into physical realities in a straightforward and cost-effective manner. OCTO has procured services from SAIC and the company has delivered both equipment and managed services in a professional and efficient manner.
