Councilmember Brandon T. Todd A BILL IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA To require the District Department of Transportation to eliminate all fares and fees for the DC Circulator and to prioritize expansion of the DC Circulator to include service in each of the District's 8 wards. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the "DC Circulator Equity Act of 2019". Sec. 2. DC Circulator fare elimination. The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) shall eliminate all fares and fees for the DC Circulator (Circulator). Sec. 3. DC Circulator expansion. (a) DDOT shall prioritize expansion of the Circulator, identify route extensions and new routes, implement the route extensions and new routes, and update the DC Circulator Transit Development Plan (TDP) to reflect the expansion. (b) Route extensions and new routes require that all eight wards are serviced by the Circulator, with emphasis on those wards without current Circulator service.

Sec. 4. Fiscal impact statement.

The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the fiscal impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975, approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).

Sec. 5. Effective date.

The act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional review as provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973, (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of Columbia Register.
