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16 To amend, on an emergency basis, the Grant Administration Act of 2013 to require a grantor
17 agency to maintain records of any sole source justifications and final agency justifications

24 phrase “records of any” and inserting the phrase “records of any sole source and final agency
25 justifications related to the selection of a grantee, and any” in its place.

31 This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the
32 Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), and shall remain in effect for no longer than
33 90 days, as provided for emergency acts of the Council of the District of Columbia in section
