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A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

1 To amend section 413 of the Procurement Practices Reform Act of 2010 to include in the list of
2 procurements exempt from competition requirements the renewal extension of a Long
3 Term Subsidy Contract for Project and Sponsor Based funds from the Local Rent
4 Supplement Program, for the purposes of preserving existing housing for extremely low-
5 income residents.

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7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may
8 be cited as the “Housing Subsidy Contract Stabilization Amendment Act of 2023”.

9 Sec. 2. Section 413 of the Procurement Practices Reform Act of 2010, effective April 8,
10 2011 (D.C. Law 18-371; D.C. Official Code § 2-354.13) is amended by adding a new paragraph
11 (18) to read as follows:

12 “(18) Renewal or extension of a Long Term Subsidy Contract for the purposes of
13 preserving existing housing for extremely low-income residents, pursuant to Section 26b of the
14 District of Columbia Housing Authority Act of 1999, effective May 9,
15 2000 (D.C. Law 13-105; D.C. Official Code § 6-227).”

16 Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.

17 The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the fiscal
18 impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975,
19 approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).

20 Sec. 4. Effective date.

21 This act shall take effect after approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the
22 Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional review as
23 provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December
24 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of
25 Columbia Register.
